Annual State of the Nation Luncheon

The Annual State of the Nation Luncheon featuring Congresswoman Linda Sánchez was held on Thursday, July 31 at the Industry Expo Center in the City of Industry. This event is produced annually by the local chambers of commerce in her district.

This year the Norwalk Chamber partnered with the Downey, Industry Business Council, Montebello, Pico Rivera, Regional San Gabriel Valley, Santa Fe Springs and Whittier Area chambers of commerce.

The Industry Expo Center is a multicultural venue which hosts events from rodeos to weddings and is located in hills overlooking San Gabriel Valley.

With over 270 attendees at this year's event the luncheon opened with a color guard from Montebello American Legion Post 272. Executive Director Joanne McClasky of IBC led the Pledge of Allegiance and a welcome was provided by City of Industry Council Member Steve Marcucci.

After a lovely buffet lunch, Joy Langford, president of the Water Replenishment District Board of Directors introduced our featured speaker, Congresswoman Linda Sánchez.

Congresswoman Sánchez provided an overview of the issues that she believes are facing our District at this time. She spoke to a full room of business leaders, elected officials, and community members, and offered timely insights into national issues directly affecting local communities and the business climate.

Sánchez spoke candidly about the recent continuing resolution passed during the Biden administration and the challenges facing Congress in advancing the appropriations bill. She highlighted concerns over proposed spending cuts to key areas including public health, scientific research, USAID, Medicaid, WIC, and student financial aid.

She emphasized that Congress holds constitutional power over federal spending, and decisions being made today will have lasting effects on both

domestic and international fronts.

The Congresswoman also shared updates on trade and infrastructure, noting that 40% of all cargo entering the U.S. comes through the ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach. As the highest-ranking woman on the Trade Subcommittee, she expressed concern over the lack of a clear national trade strategy and its potential economic impact.

Touching on public safety and immigration, Sánchez addressed the recent ICE raids in California, including an incident where a Long Beach agent was arrested and a single business was raided multiple times in one week. She stressed the need for transparency and accountability, pointing out the chilling effect these raids have on local economies.

In closing, she warned of potential redistricting efforts in other states like Texas and the possibility

of similar moves in California, urging continued civic engagement and vigilance.

CALIFORNIA SENATE BILL 602 (SB 602: TRESPASS LETTERS VALID FOR 1 YEAR (OCCUPIED AND VACANT PROPERTIES). ALL LETTERS MUST BE NOTARIZED BEFORE SUBMISSION.

Steps to Submit Your Trespass Letter:

- Optional: Speed Up Processing**
